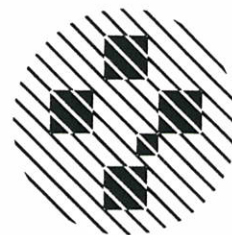

Notice of Recommendation

Whereas the Land Conservation Council has made recommendations to the Minister for Planning and Environment under paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of Section 5 of the Land Conservation Act in respect of the public land in the Gippsland Lakes Hinterland Study Area.

And whereas, pursuant to subsection (3) of section 10 of the said Act, the Minister for Planning and Environment has given not less than fourteen days' notice to the Minister administering the Department of Minerals and Energy of his intention to recommend that the Governor in Council give notice to the said Department of certain of these recommendations:

And whereas these recommendations have been published in the form of a book entitled "Final Recommendations - Gippsland Lakes Hinterland Study Area" dated February 1983 and copies have been distributed to the government departments and public authorities concerned:

Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, doth by this Order give notice to the Department of Minerals and Energy of the following recommendations:

A1-A6 (inc.); B1, C1-C3 (inc.), D1-D6 (inc.), E1-E11 (inc.), F1-F8 (inc.), G1, H1-H12 (inc.), I1-I28 (inc.), J1, J2, K1-K9 (inc.), L1-L14 (inc.), M1-M6 (inc.), N1-N7 (inc.), O1-O5 (inc.), P1, Q1-Q8 (inc.), R1-R23 (inc.), S1-S14 (inc.), T1, T2, U1, U2, V1-V3 (inc.).

And the Honourable Evan Walker, Her Majesty's Minister for Planning and Environment for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.

Dear Mr. Minister,

I refer to the implementation of the Land Conservation Council's final recommendations for the Gippsland Lakes Hinterland area.

I wish to advise that I have accepted the following amendment to recommendation A5 (Colquhoun Regional Park) which affects your department.

A5 An additional recommendation is included:

- '(d) extraction of road-making materials be permitted to continue with a review in 10 years time'

The recommendation now reads:

A5 Colquhoun Regional Park

That the area of 3,600 ha shown on the map be used to:

- (a) provide opportunities for informal recreation for large numbers of people
- (b) conserve and protect ecosystems to the extent consistent with (a) above

that

- (c) timber production be permitted
- (d) extraction of road-making materials be permitted to continue with a review in 10 years time

and that it be permanently reserved under section 4 of the *Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978* and managed by the Forests Commission.



Notes:

1. Council is aware of the importance to apiarists of round-leaf box (*Eucalyptus bauerana*) and believes that this species should be reserved for honey production wherever possible.
2. The park management authority should consult with the local Aboriginal community when preparing management plans for the area.

It would be appreciated if this recommendation with the amendment detailed above, could be implemented as soon as possible.
