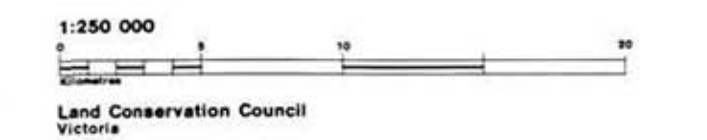

\*Grazing is also to be phased out by 1991 from the Snowy River National Park, Wabonga Plateau State Park and the Avon Wilderness, and was to cease on acceptance of the recommendations in Reference Areas C1 to C9, and C12 to C15.
