


Map symbol	Structural form (Specht)	Major species of tallest stratum	Associated species of tallest stratum	Common species of lower strata
2a	Open Forest III (27-40m)	messmate	narrow-leaf peppermint, swamp gum, manna gum, blackwood	prickly tea-tree, austral bracken, thatch saw-sedge, narrow-leaf wattle, hop goodenia, prickly mosses, snowy daisy-bush, shiry cassinia, forest wire-grass; tree-ferns and scented paper-bark in gullies.
3d	Open Forest II (15-27m)	yerichuk	often grows in pure stands; sometimes found with narrow-leaf peppermint, but-but, messmate, manna gum, saw banksia.	prickly tea-tree, burgan, austral bracken, broom spurge, thatch saw-sedge, common raspwort, common heath, narrow-leaf wattle, sunshine wattle, silver banksia, shiry cassinia, showy bossiase, smooth parrot-pea, mall-rushes, prickly guinea-flowers, dwarf rice-flowers.
3e	Open Forest II (15-27m)	narrow-leaf peppermint, manna gum (rough barked form)	but-but, swamp gum, yerichuk, (localised: saw banksia, blackwood, silver wattle, cherry ballart).	prickly tea-tree, burgan, austral bracken, thatch saw-sedge, broom spurge, silver banksia, common heath, common raspwort, tree everlasting, black she-oak, holly lomatia, shiry cassinia, showy bossiase, varnish wattle, spike wattle.
4d	Open Forest I and Woodland (lower than 15m)	shiny peppermint	messmate, yerichuk, saw banksia	prickly tea-tree, austral bracken, small grass-tree, thatch saw-sedge, silver banksia, common heath, common raspwort, broom spurge, holly lomatia, common cassinia, spike wattle, showy bossiase, mall-rushes, smooth parrot-pea.
