- The previously investigated Melbourne area has been divided into two districts to facilitate detailed investigation, with the Melbourne area District 1 Review covering the western portion. Government approved land uses where no changes are proposed are shown under the heading "Existing Reserves". However, the reference number may be different from that used in the Final Recommendations, Melbourne area, January 1977 as some categories of land use have been re-numbered to include new proposals and areas not covered in the original recommendations. In addition the sequence of numbers indicating a particular land use category on the map may be incomplete eg in bushland reserves, the number sequence I1 - I80 represents 32 separate areas in the Melbourne area, District 1.
 - Some reserves cannot be accurately defined at this map scale; these reserves are indicated by a coloured dot eg * - D10
 - Public land water frontage reserves cannot be accurately defined at this map scale nor are all reserves indicated. Refer to the appropriate Parish plan to determine the boundaries of the reserve and whether it is on one, or both, sides of the stream.
