no natural gas on tap.

method of cooking. This stove also
supplies my home with hot water.
During the summer months this
area is a high fire risk danger.

A small scale operation is essential
to logging timber for milling which
would benefit the forest immensely.
The forest floor would be freed up
of excess debris, which in turn

can be collected for fire wood.
A proven recycling operation for
over 200 years.

Regular seasonal burn are essential
for all our safety.
