2. This map is based on a GIS layer created by VEAC depicting government-accepted public land use recommendations and subsequent decisions. It is an updated version of Map A: Victoria's public land which was included in the discussion paper.

4. Other park (conservation): includes most parks in schedule 3 of the National Parks Act, and national heritage park.
5. Multiple-use marine protected area: includes marine park, and marine and coastal park.
6. Cores and links agreement area: includes plantation areas available for once only harvest. See section 2.4.2 of the discussion paper for more information.
