Notes:

- Some reserves cannot be accurately defined at this map scale; these reserves are indicated by a coloured dot, eg. ● D1
- The existing Cooracambra State Park (13 400 ha) is part of the area now recommended as the Cooracambra National Park (A13)
- The areas of rainforest in East Gippsland have yet to be accurately mapped. The rainforest symbol depicted on this map is ONLY an indication of its distribution. More detailed mapping of this community may well reveal additional sites and also show that some areas depicted may not in fact contain rainforest.
- The category called 'State forest' includes heathlands, swamplands and other vegetated public land from which timber products will not be taken. It is a descriptive name only, rather than a term defined in the Forests Act.
