- Wildlife Reserves D11 and D12 are also to be used for water supply purposes, and managed by the Fisheries and Wildlife Division in consultation with the State Rivers and Water Supply Commission.
- Wildlife Reserve D13 is also to be used for hardwood timber production and managed by the Fisheries and Wildlife Division in consultation with the Forests Commission.
- Reserved Reserves E3 and E9 are also to be used for conservation of native animals, and managed by the Forests Commission in consultation with the Fisheries and Wildlife Division.
- Water supply reserves O18-O21 are also to be used for conservation of native animals and managed by the State Rivers and Water Supply Commission in consultation with the Fisheries and Wildlife Division.
- Indicates the existence of a public tank.
