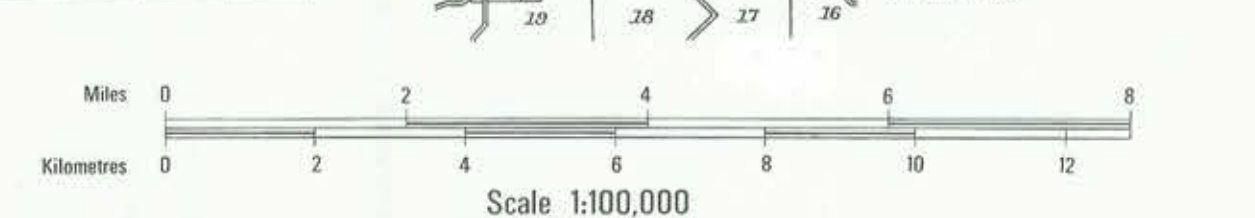
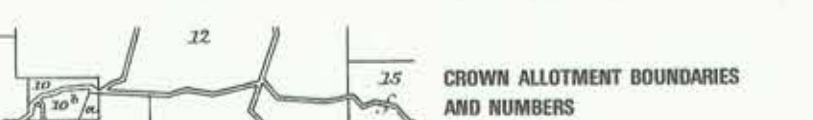

- Wildlife Reserve D13 is also to be used for hardwood timber production and managed by the Fisheries and Wildlife Division in consultation with the Forestry Commission.
- Reserved forests E8 and E9 are also to be used for conservation of native animals, and managed by the Forestry Commission in consultation with the Fisheries and Wildlife Division.
- Water supply reserves O18 - O21 are also to be used for conservation of native animals and managed by the State Rivers and Water Supply Commission in consultation with the Fisheries and Wildlife Division.
- Indicates the existence of a public tank
