Notes:

1. Coloured areas are public land. White areas are Commonwealth, local government or private land.
2. Public land use categories are those from the government-accepted recommendation R1 of the 2017 VEAC Statewide Assessment of Public Land Final Report. Appendix 1 shows the translation between this system of public land use categories and the system it replaces. Existing state parks are still labelled as such because the proposed amalgamation of this category with national park has not yet been legislated.
3. This map is based on a GIS layer created by VEAC depicting government-accepted public land use recommendations and subsequent government decisions.
4. Public land on this map includes land held by public authorities in freehold title. Figures in appendix 2 show this land.
5. Some small areas of public land may not be shown, such as public housing sites.
